Ages

- Must be Ages 6-12

Dates, Days, & Hours

- Offered Weekly:
 - Week 1: June 21 - June 25
 - Week 2: June 28 - July 2
 - Week 3: July 5 - July 9
 - Week 4: July 12 - July 16
 - Week 5: July 19 - July 23
 - Week 6: July 26 - July 30
 - Week 7: August 2 - August 6
 - Week 8: August 9 - August 13

Location

- Montgomery Township Community & Recreation Center (All 5 days)
 - 1030 Horsham Road, Montgomeryville, PA 18936
 - Both indoor and outdoor spaces will be used

Registration and Fees

- Initially, registration is open to Residents of Montgomery Township. Additional eligibility will be determined based on registration numbers.
- All fees due at time of registration via montcrc.com (\$160 per week)

Health Considerations

- Please keep your child home if you or your child is not feeling well.
- Daily health screenings will be conducted.
- Ongoing sanitation will take place with FDA approved chemicals on surfaces and shared supplies.
- Staff AND children will be required to wear facemasks over their nose and mouth at all times, except when actively eating.
- Children will be socially distanced, especially during snack and lunch times.
- Children will be placed into smaller groups, or cohorts.
- Whenever possible, children will receive their own individual supplies to minimize shared contact points.
- Hand sanitizer will be readily available at all times. Restrooms with hand soap will be available as well.
- Staff training will take place prior to the program to ensure all health and safety measures are taken. Handwashing and social distancing will also be discussed with children.
- Guidelines will be updated in accordance with recommendations from the Federal CDC and local government health departments.

Drop-Off & Pick-Up

- Children may be dropped off no earlier than 8:45am
- Drop-off Procedure
 - Parents will remain in their vehicles.
 - Children will also be asked to sanitize their hands prior to joining the program.
 - Children will be signed in electronically by Site Supervisor. The system records the time of sign in.
- Pick-up Procedure
 - Parents will remain in their vehicles.
 - Children will be walked to their vehicles.
 - Site Supervisor will electronically sign out children. The system records the time of sign out.
 - Only authorized persons will be able to sign out your child. Photo ID will be checked. Please contact us in writing if you need to add any additional authorized pick-up persons to your child's file.
- If there is a need to speak with a Kids University staff member, please park your car in a parking space and approach the Community & Recreation Center's front desk.

Dress Code

- Closed-toed shoes, preferably sneakers, **must** be worn every day. No flip flops or other open-toe footwear.
- All clothing must be appropriate for children.

If Your Child Is Sick

- If your child is sick, we ask that he/she is kept home for the day. This is for the safety of all of our participants and staff.
- If your child exhibits symptoms of sickness during the program, you may be called to pick up your child early.
- Montgomery Township is always looking out for the health and safety of our participants and staff. Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, these measures will be enforced even more strictly.

Belongings

- **OUTSIDE TOYS AND ELECTRONICS ARE NOT PERMITTED.**
 - Montgomery Township will not be responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen items.
- Cell phones may be brought for use in emergencies only. Staff reserve the right to confiscate and hold phones if they are being used for any other reason. Children must tell staff if they need to use their phone, as well as the reason.

Food/Water

- Children must pack a bagged snack, lunch, and a water bottle each day.
 - Disposable bottles of water will be available during the program.
